

GLENN HAGEL STATED 21 TIMES IN QUESTION PERIOD AND DURING MEDIA SCRUMS THAT THE ANN DAVEY CONFESSION LETTER AND/OR THE SUBSEQUENT AUDIT WERE IMMEDIATELY PROVIDED TO POLICE

APRIL 25, 2007 MEDIA SCRUM

1. Upon receipt of the letter the matter was referred to the Regina City Police. The City Police encouraged that an audit would be done, **an audit was done and provided to the Regina City Police**, who after an investigation did not press charges.
2. It was reviewed by the auditor and then the **auditors report was completed and (inaudible) provided it to the City Police.**
3. The police asked that an audit be done to determine then what was an accurate statement. **That audit was done and was provided to the City Police.**
4. I just don't know what the thinking of the auditor was for the police to reach that conclusion, **but it was turned over to the City Police at that time.**
5. Well the advice of **the auditor was (inaudible) and the matter was immediately turned over to the Regina City Police.**
6. But the fact of the matter is that all of **that information was turned over, including that letter, to the Regina City Police.**
7. The Regina City Police had asked that **an audit be done (inaudible) was done and then provided to the city police** to aid in their investigation.
8. There never was a conversation with her subsequent to the time that it was received by the Chief of Staff and **it was immediately turned over, that letter and was immediately turned over to the police.**
9. The police after receiving that and **I requested they investigate**, requested that an audit be done and **the audit was done and that was turned over to the police as well.**
10. Well, the **letter was received and we thought the only appropriate thing to do having received that is to turn it over to the police and that is exactly what was done.**

APRIL 26, 2007 QUESTION PERIOD

11. Mr. Speaker, that immediately led to a meeting with the Regina City Police where the letter was disclosed, and an audit was recommended by the Regina City Police.

12. A special audit was done and turned over to the police who subsequently advised that the Regina City Police did not lay, prefer charges.

13. Mr. Speaker, let me repeat the facts. The facts are these: that when the information was received that there was the possibility of misappropriation, that information was given to the Regina City Police immediately. That fact of the matter is the Regina City Police recommended an audit to determine the actual facts. That was done. And it was that copy of that special audit was provided to the Regina City Police who subsequently, Mr. Speaker, who subsequently chose not to lay charges.

APRIL 26, 2007 MEDIA SCRUM

14..The matter came to the attention of the NDP caucus as a result of a letter written by Ms. Lord in August of 1992 and it was taken immediately to the Regina City Police. The Regina Police recommended that a special audit should be done and it was and that was also then provided to the Regina City Police

15. I believe it was just Mr. Fodey by himself with one of the officers. And after the discussion with the officer in which the letter was presented to him, it was also recommended that a special audit should be done and that was subsequently done and provided to the city police

16. And that report was turned over to the Regina City Police. It was made available to them of course.

17. The Regina City Police had received, first of all the complaint, and then made the recommendations that an audit should be conducted, then that was made available to the police.

18. It was a caucus decision to take the information to the police. That was the caucus decision.

19. When the information was received then there was clearly the suspicion that something was illegal and therefore it was taken to the police.

20. What I can tell you is that when the information became available it was taken to the police immediately and that led subsequently to the special audit which was also given to the police.

21. I believe that they received any information that the New Democratic Caucus had was made available to the police.
